	<p><b>Thumping noise</b></p>
	<p><b>BRIDGET</b> Oh good, it's stopped.</p>
	<p><b>ANNIE</b> I think <i>this</i> was the problem. Anyone for very hard boiled eggs?</p>
	<p><b>BRIDGET</b> Nick.</p>
	<p><b>NICK</b> Eh?</p>
	<p><b>BRIDGET</b> Are they your eggs?</p>
	<p><b>NICK</b> Eh?</p>
	<p><b>BRIDGET</b> I thought so! What on earth are you doing? Are you crazy?!</p>
	<p><b>HECTOR [Humming]</b> Oh, are my eggs ready?</p>
	<p><b>BRIDGET</b> Oh, your eggs, Hector.</p>
	<p><b>NICK</b> Hector's eggs, Bridget.</p>

	Is he cr-azy?!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Hector. The eggs are, erm, ruined. Perhaps some cornflakes instead?
	<b>HECTOR</b> Thank you, Bridget.
	<b>NICK [Mimicking Bridget]</b> Huh, perhaps some cornflakes instead?!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> What are you doing on our computer anyway?
	<b>NICK</b> ... Nothing! Let's just say girls, one day you will say 'Brad Pitt – urgh!! Pah!! Johnny Depp – urgh!! Pah!! Nick from next door – vroom-vroom-vroom!! The coolest stunt man in the world!
	<b>ANNIE</b> Oh, you a stunt man!!
	<b>NICK</b> Yep. I got the job on the Internet. Well, nearly. I'm waiting for confirmation.
	<b>ANNIE</b> Oh, how exciting!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> The coolest stunt man n the world - on a moped, right?
	<b>NICK</b> On a Harley-Davidson, actually.
	<b>ANNIE</b> Films! Those stars! That money! Oh! Oh! Have you seen Carina's dress in the magazine? I'd love to have a dress like that.
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Mmm, me too. It would really suit me.

	<b>ANNIE</b> How much is it?
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Oh, let's see. Erm ...
	<b>BRIDGET and ANNIE</b> How much?
	<b>ANNIE</b> Oh, I'm a student, it's too expensive for me!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> I've got a job and it's too expensive for me! We need more money.
	<b>HECTOR</b> Money? Bridget, Annie, I have something to tell you.
	<b>NICK</b> Hector, don't! It's a secret! The Romero family, one of the richest families in Argentina. Keep it a secret. Sssh.
	<b>HECTOR</b> Uh?
	<b>NICK</b> Sssh!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> What's a secret?
	<b>HECTOR</b> You have been very kind.
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Yes, Hector.
	<b>NICK</b> Ha-ha, ha-ha! I'm sure Bridget and Annie have a little money! Ha-ha!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Sssh! Nick!!
	<b>HECTOR</b> So I want to, I want to give you some money.
	<b>BRIDGET and ANNIE</b>

	Yes!
	<b>HECTOR</b> So, I am going – to look for a job.
	<b>ANNIE</b> Oh ... that's a great idea, Hector.
	<b>NICK</b> Gr-eat!!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Yeah, we can look for a job on the Internet, can't we.
	<b>ANNIE</b> OK, here we are, job vacancies.
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Well, let's see.
	<b>ANNIE</b> Oh well, there's a job in a launderette.
	<b>ANNIE and BRIDGET</b> Hector! No!.
	<b>ANNIE</b> And there's a job as a gardener.
	<b>ANNIE</b> My plant!
	<b>ANNIE and BRIDGET</b> No! And here's a job as a cook.
	<b>ANNIE and BRIDGET</b> No.
	<b>ANNIE</b> Wait a minute! Look at this. A waiter!
	<b>ANNIE</b> What a great idea!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Yes! Ooh, I love good looking waiters!

	<b>NICK</b> Did you say 'good looking'? Here I am.
	<b>ANNIE</b> What about Hector as a waiter?
	<b>HECTOR</b> A waiter?
	<b>NICK</b> Yeah, you know <i>[whistles]</i>
	<b>HECTOR</b> Oh, but I don't know how.
	<b>NICK</b> Oh, don't worry. I will teach you!
	<b><i>Telephone rings</i></b>
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Hello! Howard! How are you?!! <i>[Laughs]</i> Oh, thank you Howard! Me? Dinner tonight! Seven o'clock – at the Singing Parrot Café, OK Howard! Bye Howard! That was Howard.
	<b>ANNIE, NICK and HECTOR</b> No!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> He's invited me to dinner tonight, because he wants to – talk to me about a NEW JOB!
	<b>HECTOR</b> Who is Howard?
	<b>ANNIE</b> Bridget's boss.
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Ah, he is so rich, he's so clever and he wants to see me!! He might offer me a promotion! What shall I wear? I have nothing to wear! No, wrong!
	<b>NICK</b>

	Huh!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> So last season.
	<b>NICK</b> Bet Howard can't ride a motorbike.
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Nope!
	<b>ANNIE</b> ... He does give Bridget promotion, although I have heard – Howard has a nickname!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> What was I thinking?!
	<b>NICK</b> What?
	<b>ANNIE</b> <i>[whispers]</i> An octopus!
	<b>NICK</b> An octopus?!
	<b>HECTOR</b> Oh, the octo-pus!
	<b>NICK</b> Is he meeting her alone?
	<b>ANNIE</b> Yes. No, no! Bridget needs help!
	<b>HECTOR</b> We must stop her!
	<b>NICK</b> I have an idea. Why don't you eat here?
	<b>BRIDGET</b> No!
	<b>ANNIE</b> Yes, then we can both talk to your boss about your new job!
	<b>BRIDGET</b>

	Where, here? No, no way.
	<b>NICK</b> I could cook for you!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Huh! Definitely not, no!
	<b>HECTOR</b> And I could be your waiter!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Mmm.
	<b>HECTOR</b> I <i>want</i> to be your waiter.
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Yeah, OK then, but be serious!
	<b>NICK</b> But don't worry, we will help you get your promotion. Leave it to us!
	<b>ANNIE [composing email]</b> 'Nadia. Hector wants a job.'
	<b>HECTOR</b> I am going – to look for a job.
	<b>ANNIE</b> 'But it's difficult. What can he do? He can't work in a launderette and he can't work as a gardener.'
	<b>ANNIE</b> My plant!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Hmm. <b>[Composing email]</b> 'He can't work as a cook, but then we saw the job for Hector, a waiter.'
	<b>HECTOR</b> A waiter?
	<b>NICK</b> Yeah you know. <b>[Whistles]</b> <b>[Composing email]</b> 'And Bridget's boss, Howard wants to take her out to dinner tonight.'

	I wonder why?'
	<b>NICK</b> OK, Hector, you are the waiter, so you must set the table.
	<b>HECTOR</b> Yes, I have set the table, but there is one problem.
	<b>NICK</b> A problem?
	<b>HECTOR</b> The table is too small.
	<b>NICK</b> The table is too small?
	<b>HECTOR</b> Yes, look.
	<b>NICK</b> Hector, this is set for twelve courses!
	<b>HECTOR</b> Dinner at home is always like this.
	<b>NICK</b> Oh yes! You are a million... <i>[whispers]</i> You are a millionaire. This is just a little dinner for Bridget's boss – OK?
	<b>HECTOR</b> OK.
	<b>NICK</b> OK. I am a customer!
	<b>HECTOR</b> Where would you like to sit?
	<b>NICK</b> Hmm. Here. <i>[Clears throat]</i>
	<b>HECTOR</b> Oh, I ... .. The bill. <b>NICK</b> Not yet! The menu first!



	<b>HECTOR</b> Oh, sorry, erm ... <i>[clears throat]</i> The menu.
	<b>NICK</b> Forget the menu. What have you got today?
	<b>HECTOR</b> To eat?
	<b>NICK</b> To eat.
	<b>HECTOR</b> Today, as dish of the day, I have a delicious hot cat.
	<b>NICK</b> A hot cat?! That's a hot dog.
	<b>HECTOR</b> Ah! Hot cat, hot dog! <i>[Laughs]</i> ... Cat, hot ... <i>[Laughs]</i>
	<b>NICK</b> Oh no!
	<b>ANNIE</b> Oh, how's it going?
	<b>HECTOR</b> Great! Nick is a good teacher.
	<b>ANNIE</b> Let's see.
	<b>NICK</b> Ah-ah, Hector's café is now closed.
	<b>HECTOR and ANNIE</b> Oh!!
	<i>Sound of knocking on door</i>
	<b>ANNIE</b> I'll get it.
	<b>DELIVERY MAN</b> Delivery, Miss Evans and Miss Taylor.

	<b>ANNIE</b> Oh, Thank you! Bridget, look!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Oh! <b>[Reading card]</b> 'For lovely Annie from H.'
	<b>ANNIE</b> For beautiful Bridget from H. Who's H?
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Oh, it must be Howard! Oh, what is it!
	<b>ANNIE</b> Oh, Bridget! Look, it's Carina's dress! But how did he guess?!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Oh, he's a clever man! Anyway, it's not Carina's dress now, it's Bridget's dress! Oh, thank you Howard!
	<b>ANNIE</b> Oh Bridget, isn't your boss kind! But, why did he buy me one?
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Oh, I've told him all about you!
	<b>BRIDGET [composing email]</b> 'Chrissy, Howard, my boss is coming to dinner!'
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Me, dinner, tonight! 'He wants to talk to me about a new job. I'm so excited.'
	<b>BRIDGET</b> He's so clever and he wants to see me! 'He even sent me a dress!'
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Thank you Howard! Ah!
	<b>NICK [composing email]</b> His nickname is <i>The Octopus</i> .

	<b>HECTOR</b> The octopus!
	<b>NICK</b> Ugh! 'Anyway - Hector and I will prepare and serve a good dinner this evening.'
	<b>NICK</b> We will help you get your promotion.
	<i><b>Sound of eggs being beaten</b></i>
	<b>BRIDGET</b> <i><b>[Clears throat]</b></i>
	<b>NICK</b> Wow!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> OK, Nick?!
	<b>NICK</b> Yeah. Hot. The soup, hot.
	<b>HECTOR</b> Ah-ah-ah-ah. The soup <i>is</i> hot.
	<b>NICK</b> Thank you Hector.
	<i><b>Sound of knocking on door</b></i>
	<b>BRIDGET</b> He's here. Good evening Howard.
	<b>HOWARD</b> Ah Bridget, my princess!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Please come in.
	<b>HOWARD</b> Bridget, you look divine. Oh, this must be An-nie. Are you sisters? Such beauty!

	<b>Laughter</b>
	<b>HOWARD</b> The dresses are exquisite!
	<b>ANNIE</b> Oh ...
	<b>BRIDGET and ANNIE</b> ... Thank you.
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Thank you.
	<b>HOWARD</b> Don't thank me, it's a privilege!
	<b>ANNIE</b> Oh and this of course is Nick.
	<b>NICK</b> Hi.
	<b>BRIDGET</b> And this is Hector. He's from Argentina.
	<b>HECTOR</b> Hello.
	<b>HOWARD</b> Argentina. Do you have a cow?
	<b>HECTOR</b> Two million!
	<b>HOWARD</b> What?
	<b>HECTOR</b> My parents own two million cows.
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Ah yes, thank you Hector. Hector's English is a little ...
	<b>HOWARD</b> Weird! Never mind, 'Ector.
	<b>HOWARD</b>

	So Bridget [ooh] what a beautiful apartment, for a beautiful lady.
	<b><i>Banging noise</i></b>
	<b>HECTOR</b> Dinner is served!
	<b>NICK</b> Hector, go on!
	<b>HECTOR</b> Today, we have sick pea soup.
	<b>HOWARD</b> Mmm, sick pea soup, my favourite!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Chick pea, chick pea!
	<b>HECTOR</b> [Erm] Chick pea soup.
	<b>HOWARD</b> <b><i>[Laughing]</i></b> This guy is great! Where did you find him?! Sick pea soup! <b><i>[Laughs]</i></b> Mind you, it does look like – ugh! <b><i>[Laughs]</i></b> Sorry Nick!
	<b>HECTOR</b> Main course. Teeth casserole.
	<b>HOWARD</b> Teeth casserole?
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Beef, beef.
	<b>HECTOR</b> Oh sorry, beef casserole!
	<b>HOWARD</b> I bet the beef is as hard as teeth! <b><i>[Laughs]</i></b> A dinner with bite! Oh! Sorry, Nick! So Bridget, you would like a better job?
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Well Howard, I, I ...

	<b>HOWARD</b> Are you willing to work harder, hah?
	<b>HOWARD</b> You stupid idiot!
	<b>HECTOR</b> Sorry, erm ... !
	<b>HOWARD</b> And Bridget, with your good looks ...
	<b>NICK</b> What a creep!
	<b>HOWARD</b> Ay! It's cold! 'Ector! I want hot coffee!
	<b>HECTOR</b> He wants hot coffee.
	<b>NICK</b> Then he will have hot coffee!
	<b>HOWARD</b> So – by the age of twenty <i>[snoring noise]</i> I had fifty people working for me.
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Fascinating!
	<b>HOWARD</b> My father said <i>[snoring noise]</i> – if you want more money, you must work hard!
	<b>HOWARD</b> Ay! You have poisoned me! You fool, you stupid boy!
	<b>ANNIE</b> Stupid!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Don't you dare talk to my friend Hector like that!
	<b>HOWARD</b> Oh, what is he? Is he your boyfriend or something?!

	<b>BRIDGET</b> He is – A kind and clever and lovely man, which is something that you will never, ever be! So you can keep your job, you creep!
	<b>ANNIE</b> And we'll send you back the dresses!
	<b>HOWARD</b> What dresses?
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Oh, these dresses, the ones you bought Annie and me!
	<b>HOWARD</b> I did not buy those dresses. I would not spend money on you! Hah!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Goodbye Howard!
	<b>HOWARD</b> You've lost your job!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> Well too late, I quit!!
	<i><b>Sound of door slamming/applause</b></i>
	<b>NICK</b> Howard said he did not buy the dresses. So who did?
	<b>BRIDGET</b> If 'H' isn't for Howard?
	<b>ANNIE</b> Then 'H' is for Hector!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> You, but why did you buy the dresses?
	<b>HECTOR</b> To say thank you.
	<b>BRIDGET</b> But they're so expensive. Where did you get the money?

	<b>NICK</b> <i>[Clears throat]</i>
	<b>HECTOR</b> I – found it.
	<b>ANNIE</b> Well, these expensive dresses must go back to the shop.
	<b>ANNIE</b> Yes they must! But not until tomorrow.
	<b>ANNIE</b> That's right, let's go clubbing! Come on, Nick! Hector!
	<b>BRIDGET</b> See you later, boys!
	<b>NICK</b> Hector, you are a true, true friend. Money is not everything. So, what did you buy me?
	<b>HECTOR</b> What do you think?
	<b>NICK</b> I love you, I love you!
	<b>HECTOR</b> Hmm! One moment.
	<b>NICK</b> You didn't buy me a bike, you didn't buy me a bike, you didn't buy me a bike. You didn't buy me a bike.
	<b>HECTOR</b> OK!
	<b>NICK</b> Thanks, Hector. It's really, really ...
	<b>HECTOR</b> It's OK Nick.
	<b>NICK</b> Hop on, I'll give you a lift.



	<b>HECTOR</b> Hey ...
	<b>NICK</b> Hey, so do you still want to be a waiter?
	<b>HECTOR</b> No, I want to be like you, Nick, a stunt man!
	<b>NICK and HECTOR</b> Aaah!!
	<b>COMMENTARY [v.o.]</b> <i>Next time in EXTRA!</i> <i>Nick gets a job on TV.</i> <i>Annie loves watching TV.</i> <i>And why does Hector want to learn to cook?</i> <i>EXTRA – don't miss it!</i>
